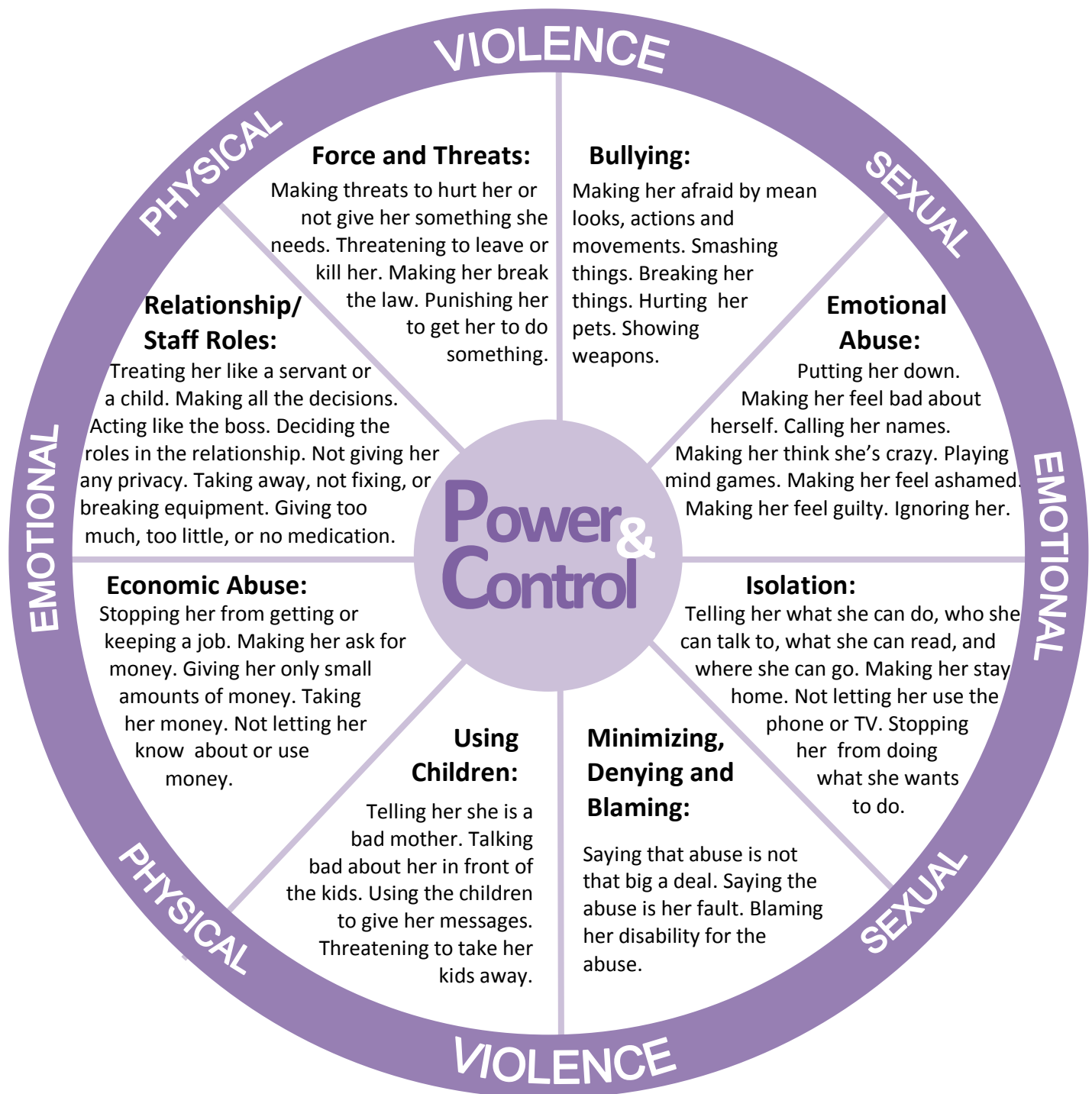

Power and Control Wheel for Women with Developmental Disabilities and/or Mental Health Issues



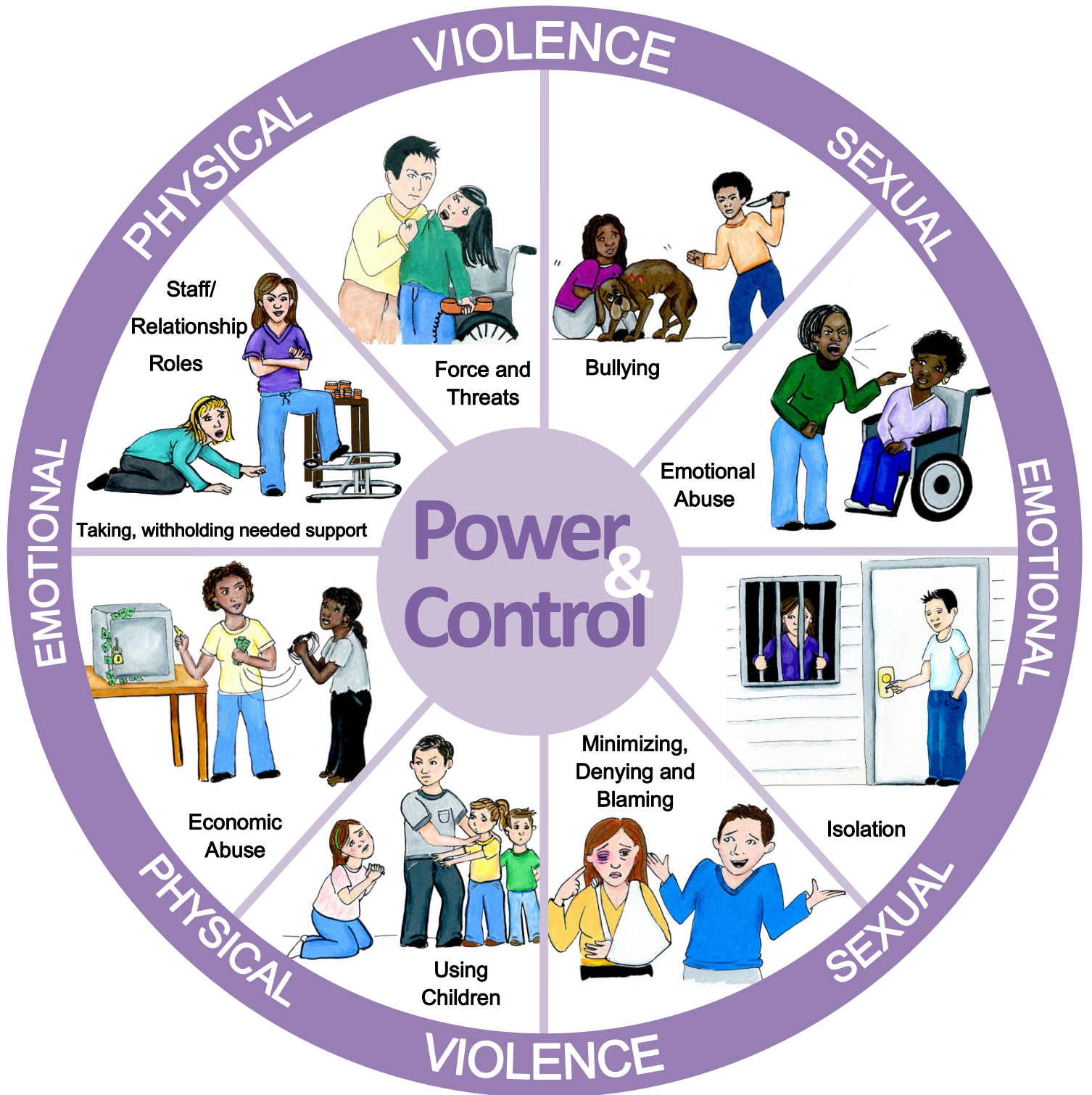
